## PHOTO GUIDELINES

When providing OneChild with your leader's photo, please adhere to the following guidelines so that we can create the best possible piece for your event!

- Choose a photo that shows your leader's whole face, as well as part of his or her shoulders and torso.
- Choose a photo that is well lit; a photo taken outdoors in the shade or on a cloudy day will look much more inviting than a photo taken in a dark room with a flash or outside with bright sunshine and harsh shadows.
- Make sure that the photo is in focus and is not blurry.
- Make sure that the file size is at least 2MB. If the file is too small, it may appear pixelated or blurry when printed. The file size will vary depending on what kind of camera was used to take the photo, but making sure the file size is at least 2MB is a good starting point.
